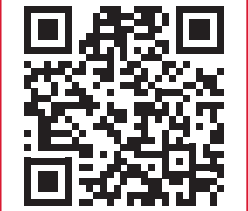

- Experiences** We facilitate spiritual encounters that give life new meaning and purpose.

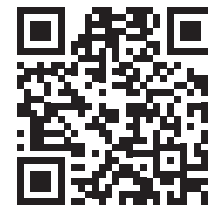


STARTING A NEW GROUP

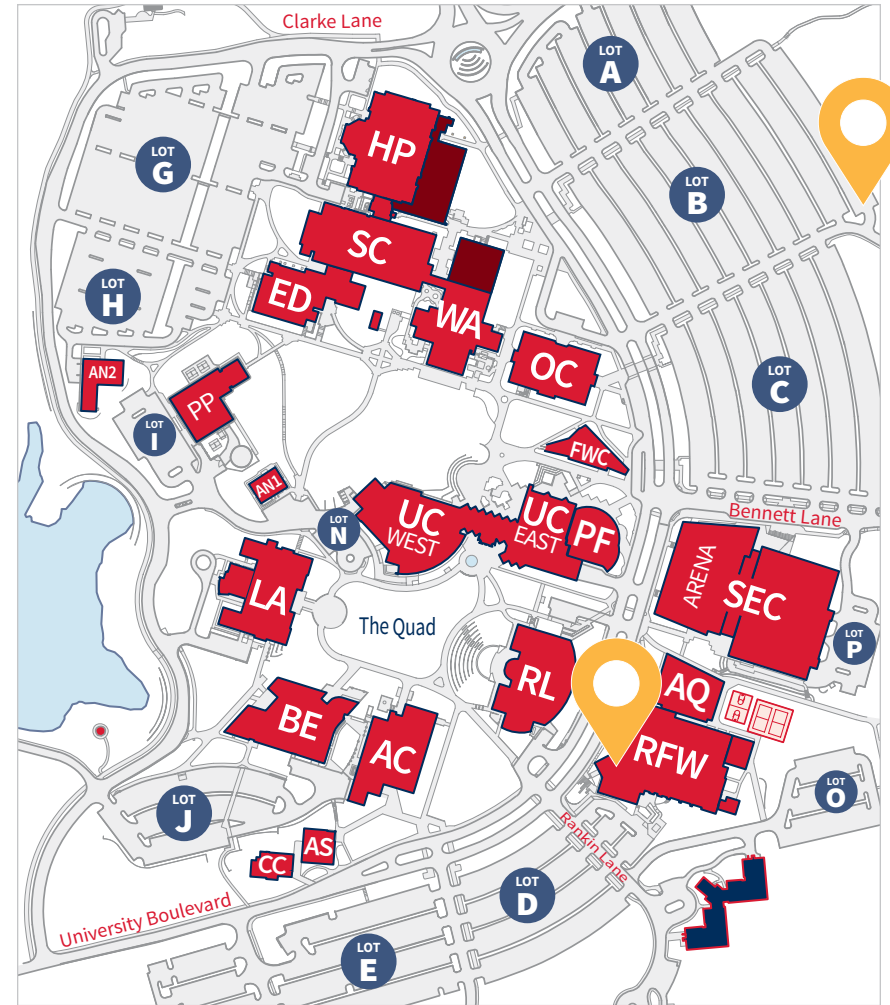

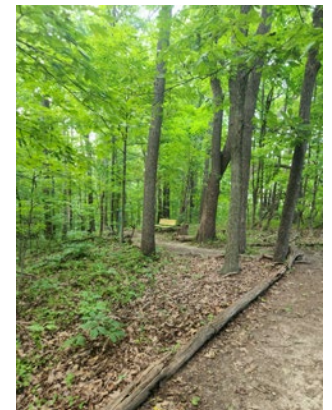

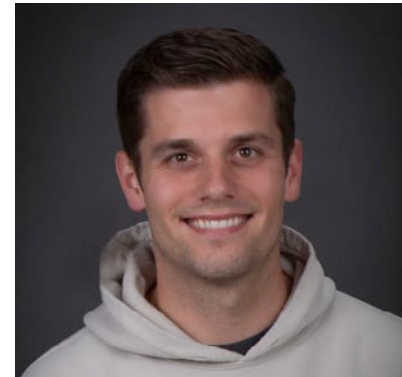
Many of our students also worship together each Sunday at the 10:45 a.m. service at CFC.
