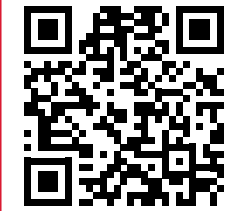

- Experiences** We facilitate spiritual encounters that give life new meaning and purpose.

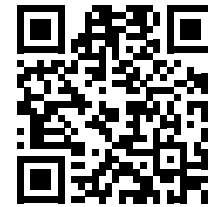


STARTING A NEW GROUP
